Introduction

Proveca Limited disclose Transfers of Value ('ToVs') made to Healthcare Professionals ('HCPs') and Healthcare Organisations ('HCOs') in line with the requirements of the European Federation of Pharmaceutical Industries Associations ('EFPIA') code and the Code for Pharmaceutical Advertising (the CGR).

ToVs are direct or indirect payment, whether in cash, in kind or otherwise or reimbursement provided to HCPs and HCOs.

Kinds of ToVs (EFPIA)	Contribution to Costs related to Events

Support providing or covering the costs of meals, travel, accommodation and/or registration fees to support the attendance of an individual HCP to an Event organised or created by a Proveca and/or a Third Party.
Donations and Grants
Funds, assets or services freely given for the purpose of supporting healthcare, scientific research or education, with no consequent obligation on the recipient to provide goods or services to the benefit of the donor in return.
<u>Sponsorship</u>
Support provided by or on behalf of a Member Company, when permitted by law, as a contribution to support an activity (including an Event) performed, organised or created by a HCO or a Third Party.
Fees for Service and Consultancy
ToVs resulting from or related to contracts between Proveca and HCPs/HCOs under which such HCPs/HCOs provide any type of services to Proveca or any other type of
funding not covered in the previous categories. Fees, on the one hand, and on

the other hand ToVs relating to expenses agreed in the written agreement covering

the activity will be disclosed as two

separate amounts.
